Who is the course for?

Specific Learning Disabilities describes a group of related conditions that often overlap or occur together which affect the way individuals learn and the way information is processed. They are neurological — arising from differences in the structure of the brain and do not relate to levels of intelligence

What are the benefits of doing this course?

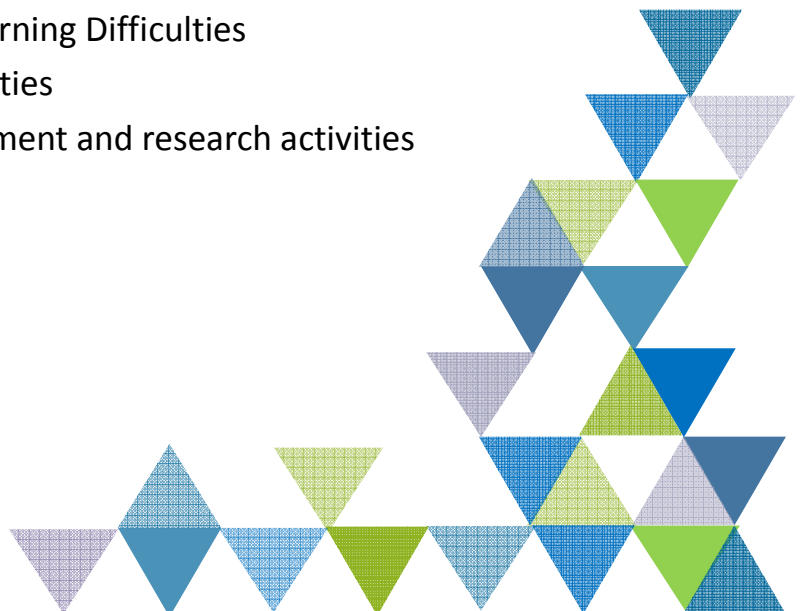
The course will develop understanding of Specific Learning Difficulties and the different types of difficulty that individuals face, how it affects them and those around them.

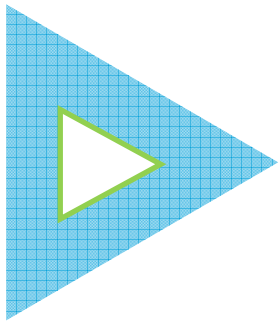

Course content

The Level Certificate in Understanding Specific Learning Difficulties comprises seven sections across two module workbooks as follows:

- ▶ Resource development and research activities
- ▶ The diagnosis of Specific Learning Difficulties
- ▶ Supporting individuals with Specific Learning Difficulties

- ▶ Resource, case study/scenario development and research activities

By undertaking this programme, candidates will be able to further their own continuous professional development, which may improve their career prospects.

Course delivery and assessment

The programme enables learners to complete the course in their own time, and all study material and resources are provided.
