Who is the course for?

This course is aimed at anybody willing to improve their knowledge and understanding of common health conditions. It will appeal to those who either have a personal/professional interest in arthritis care, stroke, dementia, Parkinson's disease and sensory loss awareness or organisations within the health and social care sector.

What are the benefits of doing this course?

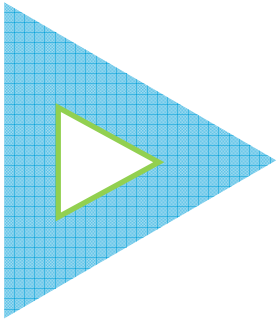
Along with achieving a nationally recognised qualification, this course will help to encourage or consolidate good practice within the workplace. The course is designed to provide insight into the signs, symptoms, risk factors and treatment options for each of the common health conditions, enabling the individual or workforce to transfer these skills across to improve the quality of life of those living with these conditions.

Course content

The Level 2 Certificate in Common Health Conditions comprises six units across three module workbooks as follows:

- ▶ Arthritis awareness
- ▶ Stroke awareness
- ▶ Dementia awareness
- ▶ Parkinson's Disease awareness
- ▶ Sensory loss awareness
- ▶ Understand how to contribute to monitoring the health of individuals affected by health conditions





Progression opportunities

By undertaking this programme, candidates will be able to further their own continuous professional development, which may improve their career prospects.

Course delivery and assessment

The programme enables learners to complete the course in their own time, and all study material and resources are provided. Learners have access to a tutor and the programme is marked based on modular assessment. There is also the opportunity to work through a series of reflective activities designed to reinforce the learning.

Learners should be aged 16 and over but otherwise there are no specific entry requirements for this programme.
