

Certificate in Understanding Behaviour that Challenges – Level 2

Who is the course for?

Behaviour can be defined as challenging if it puts the person displaying the behaviour, or people around them, at risk or if it leads to a poorer quality of life.

This nationally recognised qualification is aimed at those who support or work with, or would like to support or work with individuals with challenging behaviour.

What are the benefits of doing this course?

The course will enable learners to understand the meaning of challenging behaviour and the different types of behaviour this includes. It will look at identifying patterns of behaviour and ways to support individuals to take avoidance actions.

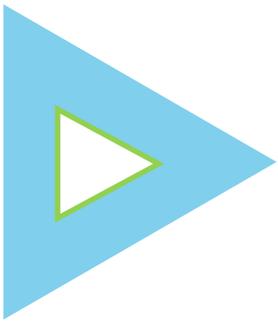
The course will also consider methods of communication, its impact and the support services available.

Course content

The Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Behaviour that Challenges comprises six sections across two module workbooks as follows:

- ▶ Understand behaviour that challenges
- ▶ Understand how to support positive behaviour
- ▶ Scenario development
- ▶ Understand the importance of effective communication and the management of behaviour that challenges
- ▶ Understand the role of reflection and support for those involved in incidents of behaviour that challenges
- ▶ Practical resource development and research activities





Progression opportunities

By undertaking this programme, candidates will be able to further their own continuous professional development, which may improve their career prospects.

Entry requirements

Learners should be aged 18 and over but otherwise there are no specific entry requirements for this programme.

Course delivery and assessment

The programme enables learners to complete the course in their own time, and all study material and resources are provided.

Learners have access to a tutor and the programme is marked based on modular assessment. There is also the opportunity to work through a series of reflective activities designed to reinforce the learning.
